

## **THE PRE AND POST KINSEY IMPACT ON SEX EDUCATION, DISEASE AND DYSFUNCTION.**

Examining the public health data pre-Kinsey, FBI Director Herbert Hoover's warning that the USA was experiencing a crime wave seems ludicrous. When one compares the sexual disorders and diseases on record for the 1950s to the year 2000, the 1950s emerges as paradise lost. However, the FBI Uniform Crime Report for 1952, concurrent with the drafting of the Model Penal Code, announced:

Over 2 million major crimes for the year resulted from an upswing in all crime categories in 1952. Crimes of violence rose 10.2 percent throughout the nation....Murder 5.7 percent; rape, 2.6 percent....as designated by the International Association of Chiefs of Police under the uniform crime reporting system....the total major crime figures are considered conservative."( FBI UCR, 1952, p. 73).

Even in 1950 statutory rape comprised 44.5% of all rape arrests, 46.3% in 1952, 45% in 1953 and by 1954 statutory rape was 49.3% of all rape arrests. By eliminating statutory rape from the FBI UCR, the public was lulled into a false sense of security, accepting the Model Penal Code claims that laws against fornication, cohabitation, adultery, seduction, alienation of affection, obscenity/pornography, abortion, sodomy and the like might legitimately be eliminated or largely disregarded. The lowering of the age of consent from 21 or 18 to 16 or less (age 10 urged by the MPC), coincided with the trivialization of all of these marital protecting, woman and child protecting laws as well as the effort to bring graphic "sex education" into the schools.

And, how would the sexual revolutionaries craft a new, revolutionary people in the USA, unless it was done directly via the school system? So, legalizing what is now common "sex education," required first capturing millions of children annually. Once captured, as "education," the sexperts distributed, read and showed children sexually graphic materials which were—considered to contribute to the delinquency of minors and still are—pornographic and wholly illegal *except* for educational or scientific purposes.
